



Recognised Breastfeeding Support Counsellor Organisations

The term “breastfeeding support counsellor” is used by IBLCE to identify individuals who obtain their lactation care experience in one of the following ways:

- Volunteer, accredited breastfeeding support counsellors such as La Leche League Leaders and Australian Breastfeeding Association Counsellors
- Paid or volunteer breastfeeding support counsellors who work within a health care delivery organisation such as a hospital, birth centre or community clinic

The Breastfeeding Support Counsellor Organisation must provide:

- structured training programs for their counsellors which includes comprehensive education in breastfeeding and lactation management
- a Code of Ethics or Professional Conduct
- structured supervision for counsellors, with an appropriate level of training
- a continuing education program for counsellors

IBLCE understands that not every breastfeeding support counsellor organisation which meets these criteria may be on this list.
