



## **Nursing Accommodation Privacy Tent for breast feeding**

### **General Guidelines for Candidate Use**

#### **Purpose:**

In order to support the wellness and parenting needs of candidates, based upon recent COVID19 protocols, Nursing Persons' with child will be provided a functional, private space dedicated for the purpose of breastfeeding. Privacy is of our utmost concern in providing this space.

#### **Each space includes:**

Privacy tent and a comfortable chair. Privacy tent features a large zippered "T" style door for easy access and a 3-way zipper closure. **To ensure privacy, the test taker must ensure the privacy tent must be closed completely.**

#### **Are there any limitations on how the space may be used?**

- Privacy tent is dedicated for the purpose of breastfeeding only. The tent expands to the size of 47.24" x 47.24" x 78.74", providing a spacious area with a top window for light and air circulation inside the tent.
- A chair will be available for use; the Test Center Administrator will roll it inside the privacy tent when setting up the space. No additional table, chair or stool is available.
- To ensure privacy, the tent must be closed completely. Privacy tent features a large zippered "T" style door for easy access and a 3-way zipper closure.
- Test Takers will need to be inspected as per normal security procedures every time they enter the main test room after using the tent.
- For cleanliness and out of courtesy for other users, it is the test takers responsibility to clean up any spills or other untidiness creating during use of the privacy tent.
- Food is not permitted in the tent however candidate supplied water is allowed after inspection.
- Once the test taker begins their nursing accommodation break, they are permitted to use the test center phone to call the child caretaker.
- The Caretaker will be permitted to access the Waiting / Reception Area only. They must not access the Employee Break Room, TCA Room, or Test Room.
- Caretaker will be requested to leave the test center for the duration of the extended break by the test taker.
- Once test taker has completed nursing their child, the test taker can use the test center phone to call the caretaker to bring the child back.
- Test Takers are encouraged at all times to consider the test experience of other exam candidates and to minimize disruption in the Test Center to every extent possible; Test Center staff maintain discretion at all times to require a baby who is causing disruptions to other candidates to be removed from the Testing Center.
